



## About Petersfield Climate Action Network

Petersfield Climate Action Network is an environmental charity set up by local residents in and around Petersfield, Hampshire. We were registered as a CIO (Charitable Incorporated Organisation) in December 2020, charity number 1192778.

Our mission is to help Petersfield and surrounding villages reduce their carbon emissions and protect nature, which we do by leading and supporting decarbonisation and nature projects in the community. We work with local people and organisations to help make the changes to our buildings, transport, natural environment, understanding and behaviour that our community needs to live sustainably. Our vision is for the Petersfield area to become carbon neutral as quickly as possible, given the IPPC's recommendation for carbon emissions to halve by 2030 from 2019 levels.

PeCAN is made up of its volunteers, including ten trustees, 1700+ followers, and a small, part-time staff team.

## Energy Adviser (3 days)

This is a part-time role (3 days per week) providing Energy and Retrofit Advice as part of the Hampshire “My Home Made Better” project, funded by the Energy Industry Voluntary Redress Scheme Carbon Emissions Reduction Fund.

## Responsibilities

- Lead the implementation and delivery of the “My Home Made Better” service in Petersfield and south east Hampshire
- Carry out advice calls (telephone and/or online meeting) to 540 unique households.
- Provide face to face retrofit advice to 90 additional unique households.
- Provide light-touch retrofit advice at events to an additional 400 unique households.
- The total number of unique households reached is 1030 over the duration of the project (running until end October 2026)
- Recruit and train 34 Green Home Champions
- Carry out customer surveys to gauge satisfaction and impact
- Develop and manage projects in line with PeCAN objectives and priorities
- Build PeCAN’s support and profile in the local community

## Tasks

- Lead the delivery and implementation of the “My Home Made Better” in Petersfield and south-east Hampshire, acting as a point of contact for project participants and volunteer Energy Champions.

- Develop a local marketing plan for the project and work with PeCAN Marketing and Communications Manager to ensure this is delivered.
- Work with relevant external organisations to make links and promote the objectives of the project as required.
- Deliver energy advice to 1030 unique households – via telephone, online meetings and events – and log details as required by the project.
- Recruit and train 34 Energy Champions to provide retrofit information and signposting/referrals for advice where appropriate.
- Respond to enquiries from the general public about the project.
- Work with PeCAN trustees, the Environment Centre and other partner groups to ensure that work plans are set, progress against plans is monitored, and identify where action is needed to ensure plans are implemented.
- Attend project management meetings and other relevant meetings.
- Complete the general administrative tasks, including logging of relevant customer details, related to the project as required.
- Assist PeCAN trustees with budgeting and financial reporting for the project.
- Support PeCAN trustees to build the profile of PeCAN and “My Home Made Better” within the local community.
- Undertake relevant training where needed.
- Assist with other PeCAN projects, as a secondary priority, where time and resource allows.

## **Terms and Conditions**

**Remuneration:** £18,000 per annum gross (equivalent to £30,000 FTE)

**Hours:** 3 days (22.5 hours) per week. Occasional evening and weekend work may be required.
